MISEREOR, would like to express its full commitment to the International Year of Rangelands and Pastoralists (IYRP) proposed by the Government of Mongolia. We have been informed that a resolution in support of such a designation will be discussed at the upcoming meeting of the Committee on Agriculture (COAG) of the Food and Agriculture Organization of the United Nations (FAO) at the end of September 2020. We therefore reiterate our support for the designation of an IYRP and commit ourselves to actively shaping the IYRP.
