
# Vence HerdManager Starting Out

Unavoidable circumstances


- Batteries on collars will run out

#### Virtual Fences

All changes to a herd programming take time

- Removing a programmed VF fence and reuploading take double the upload time
- Leaving uploaded fences and saving adjustments shortens this upload time
